ODM politics I'm ready to take up the position my father held as Nairobi ODM delegate, Raila's daughter says

Winnie backed for Oburu's deputy post

ODM Nairobi delegates want the party's constitution amended to create an additional position of deputy party leader

East African Legislative Assembly (Eala) member Winnie Odinga says she is ready to work with Dr Oburu Oginga to strengthen the Orange Democratic Movement (ODM).

Ms Odinga has previously been associated with the ODM faction led by secretary-general, Mr Edwin Sifuna, and Siaya Governor James Orenge. But she now says she will work with her uncle, Dr Oginga.

"This party is our home. The home that my father built. How can I leave this home? To go where? I will remain here in ODM," Ms Odinga said.

She spoke yesterday during an ODM Nairobi branch meeting chaired by Makadara Member of Parliament George Aladwa at the Jaramogi Oginga Odinga Foundation offices.

Nairobi ODM delegates endorsed a proposal to amend the party constitution to allow the

creation of an additional position of deputy party leader. The proposal will be presented to the ODM leadership ahead of the March 27 National Delegates Convention (NDC).

If the branch's demands are accepted, then Ms Odinga will become the fourth ODM deputy leader. The other deputies are: Kisii Governor Simba Arati, Mombasa Governor Abdulsamad Nassir and Vihiga Senator Godfrey Osotsi.

During the meeting, Mr Aladwa said that following the death of their party leader Raila Odinga last year, Nairobi does not have a delegate to represent the branch at the national convention.

"Almost every region has a delegate representing it at the NDC, but since Raila left us, we don't have one. We want Winnie Odinga to take that position. This proposal was made last year, and we are ready to submit it to the NDC," Mr Aladwa said.

In her acceptance speech, Ms

Odinga said she is ready to take over the role of her father, Raila, as Nairobi's ODM representative

at national level. "When it comes to party positions, those who put their lives

on the line should be the first to be considered. We will go to the NDC. Nairobi must have a seat at the table," Ms Odinga said.

Elective seat

She said that Nairobi County has a big number of voters who have stood by the party for years, and, therefore, they need to be represented in the decision-making organs.

"Nairobi will have its say, and on March 27 we will have our day," she said.

Kilimani Member of County Assembly Moses Ogeto welcomed the proposal to have Ms Odinga as the Nairobi representative. He

said she will breathe new life into ODM Nairobi branch.

"We will go out of our way to make sure that this party remains strong," Mr Ogeto said.

A source at the meeting said that they expect Ms Odinga to vie for an elective seat in the city during the 2027 General Election.

Meanwhile, the delegates endorsed Mr Aladwa to vie for the Nairobi governor's seat.

Mr Aladwa told the delegates that he was up to the task. He challenged other aspirants interested in running for governor on the ODM ticket to face the delegates, while expressing confidence that his loyalty to the party will be rewarded.

"It will not be about money but loyalty to the party. Let them come (opponents) and fight for the nomination. We will meet at the ballot. ODM must win the governor's seat in Nairobi during the 2027 polls," Mr Aladwa said.

At the same time, the MP criticised Nairobi Governor Johnson Sakaja who has hinted at defending his seat on the ODM ticket. He said loyalty to the party matters, and delegates will decide.
